Scribe Connectors provide the Scribe platform with three main types of access to applications- connect access, metadata access, and logic access- without any modifications. The Salesforce Connector provides the following:

CONNECT ACCESS

Connect access provides the platform with the connection through which it will acquire metadata & execute application logic.

- Each connection to Salesforce provides access to the application in the security context of the user credentials you specify.
- Optimize transaction counts through optional Bulk API access.

METADATA ACCESS

Once connected, the platform obtains the metadata necessary to populate the design interface with available entities & their fields along with supported operations. The design interface is used to configure business logic, data queries, & data transformations.

- Nearly every entity and field in Salesforce is exposed for all operations supported. This includes custom entities & fields.
- Parent & child relationships between entities are exposed allowing for flexible query options.
- Field data types and lengths are presented for ease of field mapping research.
- Picklist values are displayed to ease mapping to standard & custom picklist fields.

LOGIN ACCESS

After a map or set of maps is configured, executing or debugging the map uses the connection to execute the logic configured in the map.

- The Connector packages up logic configured by the user in the platform into Salesforce API calls.
- The Connector provides data returned by API calls to the platform for use in later map steps.
- The Connector also returns any error messages supplied by the API back to the platform to enable custom error handling.

All of this functionality is accessible within the intuitive Scribe Online platform user interface & has been fine-tuned with years of Scribe experience interfacing with the Salesforce API.

With the extent of the core API functionality & entities that are exposed to the Scribe platform, the Salesforce Connector allows any Scribe platform user to quickly create simple migrations & integrations against any entities. All of the capabilities of the Connector are immediately available on install.
